

DOCUMENTS

IMPORTANT! Please register your deliveries in advance. Only registered deliveries will be prioritised for processing. Longer waiting times are to be expected for deliveries not registered in advance. We cannot guarantee that deliveries will be unloaded on the same day if they are not registered in advance.



REGISTRATION

The driver must park in the designated parking area and then report to the registration desk with the purchase order number and the necessary documents.

WAITING AREA ON THE PREMISES / REGISTRATION DESK



We operate an automated high-bay warehouse in our logistics centre in Birr.

To ensure smooth storage, pallets must be wrapped with stretch film up to the top edge of the pallet, but not beyond.


The ends of the film must be neatly glued or welded to the cargo unit. Protruding film ends are not permitted.

PALLETS / LOAD SECURING

The goods must be delivered on undamaged, dry pallets of at least A or B quality. Pallets of inferior quality (<B) will not be exchanged or credited. Internally, additional work is needed for re-palletising.

To ensure that Euro pallets and chemical pallets can be stored and transported optimally in the high-bay warehouse in Birr, the pallets must not have **any overhang**:



Euro pallet 1200 mm × 800 mm × 1800 mm (Length × Width × Height incl. pallet), maximum weight of **1,100 kg** incl. pallet



Chemical pallet 1200 mm × 1200 mm × 1800 mm (Length × Width × Height incl. pallet), maximum weight of **1,300 kg** incl. pallet

The dimensions include the packaging material, e.g. film, cardboard, etc.

If the pallets have an **underhang**, they **must** be **secured** appropriately during transport. It must also be ensured that the goods cannot slide around on the load carrier during transport.

In general, the pallets may not be stacked in the lorry unless expressly approved by Sika Schweiz AG. If the lorry is carrying goods for other unloading locations and our goods are therefore not freely accessible, the driver is responsible for unloading and reloading the third-party material. If damage to the goods is discovered during unloading, the driver must confirm it with their signature.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

The following rules must be observed on the Birr Logistics Centre premises:

- A speed limit of 10 km/h and a smoking ban are enforced throughout the entire Birr Logistics Centre premises
- Safety chocks must be placed on the lorry and trailer during unloading
- The driver must wear their own high-vis vests, protective footwear, safety goggles and long trousers
- The driver must handle their own equipment and any provided materials in a professional manner.
- Lorries including drivers are not allowed to park or stay overnight anywhere on the industrial estate. The following service areas are located nearby: Othmarsingen service area, Birrhard service area
